Recreational Equipment Storage

City of Livonia Vision 21 Zoning Ordinance restricts parking and / or storing of recreational vehicles on premises not approved for such storage. Unoccupied recreational equipment may be housed in a residential accessory building, and no more than one (1) unit of recreational equipment may be stored in the rear yard, except that no such unit may be stored within the corner side yard, as that term is defined in Section 15.44.030 of the Livonia Code of Ordinances, as amended. The temporary parking of one (1) unit of recreational equipment on the recreational equipment owner's or user's front or side driveway shall be permitted for a period not to exceed seventy-two (72) hours cumulatively in any five (5) day period for the purpose of repairing and maintaining the Recreational Equipment unit for suitable vacation use.

Deed Restrictions

Notwithstanding the city's restrictions regarding the parking or storage of recreational vehicles, residential subdivisions may have deed restrictions that place further rules governing this activity. However, the City of Livonia does not enforce deed restrictions, and these issues need to be addressed through the respective homeowner's associations.
