Livonia is a great place to work, play, learn and grow. Ranking as the 9th largest city in Michigan, Livonia is conveniently located in the heart of Metro Detroit. With access to two major freeways (I-275 and I-96), the City is less than a 30-minute drive to regional attractions like Met-ro Airport, the Detroit Zoo, along with sports, entertainment and cultural attractions of Detroit and Ann Arbor.

The city has over 1,300 acres of recreational greenspace including 60 parks and 6 miles of trails. This makes Livonia the city with the second most public parks and nature preserves among municipalities in Michigan.
