ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 99-11J
MAGISTRATE MULTIPLE DISTRICT PLAN OF THE
16th and 18th DISTRICT COURTS

The 16th and 18th District Courts, within the County of Wayne, hereby establish a multiple district plan area.

Upon approval of the State Court Administrative Office of this multiple district plan, all district court magistrates within the multiple district area are authorized to perform those functions provided by MCL 600.8320 within the multiple district area.

All district court magistrates under this multiple district plan have been appointed pursuant to MCL 600.8501; MSA 27A.8501 and nothing in this plan shall grant powers or duties to the district court magistrate that are not authorized by statute or that exceed the authorization of the chief judge of the district in which the district court magistrate is acting.

All district court magistrates under this multiple district plan are authorized to arraign and sentence under provisions of MCL 600.8511; MSA 27A.8511, including the authority to arraign and sentence upon pleas of guilty or nolo contendere for violations of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.1 to 257.923, or a local ordinance substantially corresponding to a provision of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.1 to 257.923, except for violations of sections 625 and 625m, or a local ordinance substantially corresponding to section 625 or 625m of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.625 and 257.625m, if the punishment does not exceed 93 days in jail or a fine or both. However, the magistrate may have the jurisdiction to arraign defendants and set bond with regard to violations of sections 625 and 625m of the Michigan vehicle code, 1940 PA 300, MCL 257.625 and 257.625m, or a local ordinance substantially corresponding to section 625 or 625m of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.625 and 257.625m.

All district court magistrates under this plan are subject to the superintending control of the chief or only district court judge of the district in which one magistrate is serving.

Administrative Order 96-01J is hereby rescinded.


